



WEBINAR SESSION 8 (April 2019) – RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ACTION

National Action on WASH in HCF: Experiences from UNICEF Tanzania

These recommendations provide insight for addressing gaps in HCF in Tanzania and other low- and middle-income countries.

1. Build national capacity for implementation of WASH in HCF.
 - Train a core national facilitation team, districts and lower level teams in the implementation of WASH services in HCF.
 - Demonstrate the application of the guidelines in selecting HCF to inform a scale up.
 - Produce tools and simplified versions to facilitate implementation.
 - Ministers of Health should work with district and regional levels to appoint focal persons responsible for WASH in HCF.
2. Generate evidence on positive outcomes on WASH in HCF to inform decision making around implementation at a sub-national level.
 - Update MIS indicators as per JMP to track access levels.
3. Advocate for the prioritization of WASH in HCF and leverage funding to scale up interventions.
